We are honoured to have a very distinguished speaker.

The Rt. Hon. Lord Malloch-Brown is currently the British Government's Minister for Africa, Asia and the United Nations. He served as Deputy Secretary-General of the United Nations from April to December 2006 having been, from January 2005, the Secretary-General's Chef de Cabinet. Before the UN, he worked at the World Bank, joining in 1994 as Director of External Affairs and subsequently serving as Vice President for External Affairs and Vice-President for United Nations Affairs from 1996 to 1999. He founded the Economist Development Report and served as its editor from 1983 to 1986. Previously – from 1977 to 1979 – he was the political correspondent of The Economist. Lord Malloch-Brown is a renowned speaker and we are most fortunate that he has agreed to speak at our dinner.
